Dear Parents/Guardians:

At many private schools, parents give permission for the school to administer over the counter medications to help children in specific situations. We are going to adopt that policy here at the Storefront. Only Miss Magnolia, Ms. Lankeau, Ms. Egmont or Mr. Williams will administer the medicines.

Medicines that we will have on hand are:

- Tylenol ( children's dose) or Tylenol adult dose for children 12 and over
- Benedryl (liquid) for allergies/ congestion –
- Caladryl (for insect bites or poison ivy)
- Neosporin or Bacitracin for a small cut
- Sunblock

If you give permission for your child to have these medications, we will provide them and will send home a note informing you of when your child received them. We will keep a log of any medicine administered. We will not provide more than the dose indicated on the bottle and will call you if we have any questions about giving it to them.
